All children attending St Paul's Catholic Primary School are expected to comply fully with the School Uniform Policy, which will be strictly enforced.

### **BOYS' SCHOOL UNIFORM**

#### **RECEPTION YEAR**

<b>Item</b>	<b>Details</b>
V-necked jumper	Royal blue with school logo
Polo shirt	White
Trousers	Charcoal grey
Socks	Grey
Shoes	Black, plain school shoes No trainers or shoes that look like trainers are allowed
Coat	Warm coat or raincoat in a plain colour (no patterns, no fluffy, furry materials and no logos)
School bag	School logo book bag

#### **YEARS 1 TO 6**

<b>Item</b>	<b>Details</b>
V-necked jumper	Royal blue with school logo
Shirt with collar	White (buttoned to the neck) Long-sleeved
Blue tie	Royal blue or Yr 6 Leaders tie **
Trousers	Charcoal grey
Socks	Grey
Shoes	Black, plain school shoes No trainers or shoes that look like trainers are allowed
Coat	Warm coat or raincoat in a plain colour – (no patterns, no fluffy, furry materials and no logos)
School bag	Year 1 - 2 School logo book bag Year 3 – 6 Sensible bag (not too large)

#### **BOYS' SUMMER TERM**

The items below for boys may be worn in the summer term and to the end of September if preferred (all year groups).

**RECEPTION YEAR**

V-necked jumper or cardigan	Royal blue with school logo
Polo shirt	White
Skirt, pinafore or culottes	Charcoal grey flannel Skirts and pinafores/ culottes must be worn <u>on, or below the knee</u> - Blue/black lycra shorts may be worn underneath if required
Socks	White – knee high
Tights	Grey
Shoes	Black, plain school shoes No high/stacked heels or slip on shoes allowed No trainers or shoes that look like trainers are allowed
Coat	Warm coat or raincoat in a plain colour (no patterns, no fluffy, furry materials and no logos)
School bag	School logo book bag

**YEARS 1 TO 6**

<b>Item</b>	<b>Details</b>
V-necked jumper or cardigan	Royal blue with school logo
Shirt with collar	White – Long-sleeved (no fashion blouses)
Skirt, pinafore or culottes	Charcoal grey flannel Skirts and pinafores/ culottes must be worn <u>on, or below the knee</u> Blue/black lycra shorts may be worn underneath
Socks	White – knee high
Tights	Grey
Shoes	Black, plain school shoes No high/stacked heels allowed No trainers or shoes that look like trainers are allowed
Coat	Warm coat or raincoat in a plain colour (no patterns, no fluffy, furry materials and no logos)
School bag	School logo book bag

**GIRLS' SUMMER TERM**

The items below may be worn in the summer term and to the end of September if preferred (YEAR 1 – YEAR 5).

<b>Item</b>	<b>Details</b>
V-necked jumper or cardigan	Royal blue with school logo
Summer dress	Royal blue gingham of a simple design Blue/black lycra shorts may be worn underneath
Socks	White – ankle or knee high (No tights or leggings)

**YEAR 6 GIRLS ONLY**

<b>Item</b>	<b>Details</b>
V-necked jumper or cardigan	Royal blue with school logo
Polo shirt	White
Skirt, culottes	Charcoal grey flannel Skirts/culottes must be worn on, or below the knee Blue/black lycra shorts may be worn underneath

**PE KIT**

Children must wear PE kit for physical activity. The PE kit applies to both boys and girls.

<b>Item</b>	<b>Details</b>
T-shirt	Plain white (T-shirts in house colours can be worn in the summer term)
Shorts	Royal blue (no lycra)
Socks	Grey or white (no tights allowed for PE)
Tracksuit (no hoods allowed with the exception of Year 6)	For cold outdoor weather School royal blue tracksuits with logo will be available from the school suppliers Otherwise plain dark blue/black – no logos
Plimsolls Reception – Year 2	Black, Velcro fastening
Trainers Year 3 – Year 6	PLAIN black – no logos
PE bag	Drawstring

\*\* Ties for Year 1 and Year 6 leader ties will be presented to children from the school

### **IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

- No denim is to be worn
- Boots may be worn to travel to school in bad weather, but children should change into school shoes when they arrive in school
- Caps should be plain in colour – no branded 'snapback' hats allowed – school sun hats are available at Sumo Sams
- No hooded tops to be worn at break times, used as substitutes for winter coats etc.

### **JEWELLERY**

- If children have pierced ears they may only wear small stud earrings. One stud earring per ear lobe. No other piercings.

We would prefer these not to be worn on PE days but if they are, for Health and Safety reasons, these must be covered with tape, front and back, to offer a measure of protection.

NOTE: The taping may be done at home for younger children or just prior to the lesson by the child themselves. Staff are not permitted to apply or remove the tape.

- Time-telling watch on wrist (nothing else allowed on wrists/arms)
- No other jewellery to be worn

### **HAIR**

- Hair should be clean and, in a style, acceptable to the Catholic ethos of the school
- Neat-fitting hair ornaments may be worn – **school colours only**
- Long hair should be tied back
- No extreme haircuts are allowed.
- Logos/patterns shaved into hair or eyebrows are not allowed
- Hair dye not allowed

### **NAILS**

- No nail varnish or nail decorations are allowed

In our efforts to keep lost property to a minimum, all clothing clearly marked with the pupil's name. Whilst taking all reasonable care to see that pupils' possessions are safeguarded, the school cannot be held responsible for clothing and personal items which are lost. There is a lost property box which is stored outside on the playground. At the end of term, all lost property is transferred to the PTA second-hand uniform sale in school.
