

### Maths Home Learning letter to parents

The homework attached will show you what will be covered in your child's Maths set this week. This could be completed at home with adult support and the support of resources available online.

Please also support your child with their times tables and arithmetic.

By the end of Year 4, children are expected to know their times tables up to the 12 x tables and answer random recall questions at speed (approx. 6 seconds.) We recommend Year 3 children focus on their 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10 and 11 times tables by the end of the year. We regularly challenge children on their times tables in class and support from home will improve their confidence and fluency when applying their times table knowledge.

In Arithmetic, we have been focussing on the four operations (column addition and subtraction, methods for multiplication and division). It is important that children gain a strong understanding for all four operations. Examples for these methods can be found on the school website and there are a variety of resources available online.
