

Home Learning (over 2 weeks)

Roy Lichtenstein

- Appraise the art of Roy Lichtenstein. What do they like/dislike about it? Use art language - colour, texture, pattern.
- Roy Lichtenstein using lots of dots in his work. We are going to create a piece of work inspired by both Lichtenstein and Warhol.



- Week one - Using two colours of paint, create the outside stripes on a piece of A4. Also using bubble wrap (or using your finger if you haven't got bubble wrap) - create the dotty artwork on another piece of paper.
- Week two - Using the worksheet - colour in the superhero comic word - or create your own super hero comic word. Use bright colours so it will stand out. When this is done, cut out the bubble wrap print so it outlines your super hero comic word, then stick both on top of the stripey paper so you produce a piece of artwork similar to above.
