Maths

This week your child will complete a Maths Assessment in class. Teachers will go through these tests in class and revisit areas identified.

At home, you can support your child by revising the topics taught this term as well as the four operations.

- Place value: Comparing numbers and partitioning.
- Balancing operations.
- Multiples and Factors.
- Tenths as fractions of amounts.
- Dividing whole numbers by 10 and 100.
- Decimal place value.
- Properties of 2D Shapes.
- Lines of symmetry.
- Recognise a right angle as a quarter turn.
- Comparing angles.
- Measuring and comparing length in cm and mm.
- Telling the time to on an analogue clock.
- Roman numerals.

Once assessments have been marked and answers explained to the class, these tests will then be sent home.

These tests are used as a loose guideline to indicate whether your child is 'on track' to meet the curriculum standards for the end of the year. Each test is out of 20. A score of 11 or more suggests that your child is 'On Track' to meet the standards. A score of 17 or more suggests that your child is 'On Track' to meet the 'Higher' standards.
