
THE PARABLE OF THE WEDDING FEAST



The wedding banquet was one of the most joyous occasions in Jewish life and could last for up to a week. In His parable, Jesus compares heaven to a wedding banquet that a king (God) had prepared for his son (Jesus.) Many people had been invited (Jewish leaders), but when the time for the banquet came and the table was set, those invited refused to come. In fact, the king's servants (Prophets) who brought the joyful message were mistreated and even killed. It shows again Jesus' rejection by the Jews the very people who should have celebrated His coming. They bring judgment upon themselves. As a result, the banquet (kingdom of heaven) is then opened up to anyone and everyone, total strangers, both good and bad. This refers to the gospel being taken to the Gentiles. However it isn't that easy as Matthew says, many are "called" or *invited* with the message of repentance, but only those

who respond worthily will share the inheritance of the chosen covenant people. We pray that we will recognise the call when it comes and be prepared to share in the banquet.
